9. Description: This L-shaped, two and a half story, five bay by four bay farmhouse is frame and has asbestos shingle siding. The house faces north-east. The northeast porch is a simple gabled hood supported by two square wooden posts with brick bases. There is a one story glass enclosed porch with a shed roof on the northwest elevation. There are two-over-two double-hung windows. There is a two story bay window on the northeast elevation. The cross gable roof is covered by green corrugated metal.

10. Significance: Situated in upper Montgomery County, the Wyndo Farm is an example of a Victorian farm, and is associated with the King family, early settlers in that section of the county.

Genoa King and his wife Vinnie bought the land upon which Wyndo Farm is now situated in 1905, having moved from Damascus where they had owned a mill. The land was once part of a tract called "Trouble Enough Indeed", granted to Thomas Whitten in 1766. At the time of the Kings' purchase there were several log structures on the site. However, they built a new Victorian farm house for which they were assessed in 1907.

In 1923, the Kings sold the farm, and through subsequent owners the land more than doubled in acreage.

The name Wyndo was created by the present owners, the Doodys. They needed a farm name with which to register their Holstein cattle. As their first choice, Wyndy Ridge, was already taken, they took the first three letters of Wyndy and added the first two letters of their last name; hence Wyndo.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This L-shaped, two and a half story, five bay by four bay farmhouse is in good condition and has been much added to. It sits near the junction of Mountain View and Johnson Roads facing northeast.

Built on fieldstone foundations, this wood frame house has been covered by asbestos shingle siding. There is a porch on the northeast elevation. The northeast (front) door has a gabled hood supported by two square wooden posts with brick bases. The northeast door is a narrow wooden paneled door surmounted by a two light transom. On the northwest elevation there is an enclosed one story sun-porch with a shed roof. The awning windows are arranged in three tiers. This enclosed porch was built on poured concrete foundations. There are two-over-two double-hung windows in the original section of the house. There is a three-sided two story bay window on the northeast elevation. At the northeast cross gable there is a lancet-beaded window. In the southeast and southwest gable ends there are two small square windows (in the southwest gable one of these is obscured by the ell-roof which is lower than the roof of the main house). The cross gable roof is covered by green corrugated roofing. The cornice is boxed and returned.

Recent additions to this house include a one story stud-roofed addition to the southeast of the second two-story rear ell. A shed-roofed carport is also on the southeast elevation. The windows in these new additions are modern one-over-one double-hung.

A large frame bank barn is located southeast of the house. It has a gable roof of corrugated metal, capped by decorative metal ventilators.
